The number of Canadians over the age of 85 is expected to triple by 2046



In 2020, 597,300 individuals were living with dementia in Canada. By 2030, we can expect this number will reach close to 1 million.



Dementia affects about 15% of Canadians aged 65 and older



In 2020, 10,333 people were diagnosed per month; 348 per day; 15 every hour
